The Plan

Grower will deliver 460 flats using 2 trucks. Both trucks need to be unloaded upon arrival.
Trucks will arrive at the Geier Home between 10:30 and 11:00 AM
The time is an estimate and the grower will call when they are 1/2 hour to 45 mins. away. Grower stated worse case scenario would be a delivery time no later than 12. I will call volunteers who will unload trucks after the grower calls me. Please be sure to include your mobile or contact number when volunteering.

All available adult volunteers (10 to 15 needed) will meet at the Geier home to help unload and sort the flats by flower type at the time of delivery.

17 Adult Drivers are needed. Drivers need to have a truck, van, trailer or hatch back to accommodate flower flats.

Rowers will form their car pools upon arrival, load vehicles/truck and make deliveries.
Some routes have fewer deliveries than others. Once a route is completed, return to the Geier home to help those with bigger routes.
Rowers are responsible for their own rides home.
