## **Rent-a-Rower**

### **GUIDELINES**

Rent-a-Rower is a means for our rowers to assist the community with household projects, while meeting fundraising goals at the same time. RAR participants help customers with various jobs including yard work, babysitting, window washing, yard work, furniture, moving, etc. The program has proven to be a very successful fundraiser for both LBRA and other rowing clubs in years past.

#### **Benefits of RAR:**

The time commitment is minimal the financial payoff is significant for the time worked. RAR provides the opportunity for our rowers to be visible providing a service within the community, which benefits the club as a whole.

#### **Promotional Doorhangers:**

We have RAR door hangers available, which allow the rowers to advertise the program to homes and businesses in their neighborhoods. Door hangers can be obtained at upcoming spring regattas and at the monthly general meetings. We can also make arrangements to have door hangers brought to the boat house during practice times.

#### **Minimum RAR commitment per job:**

2 rowers for 2 hours at a total cost of \$50. The number of hours and rowers can be modified to meet the needs of the job. An adult, a LBRA parent, must supervise the rowers while working each RAR job. Rowers assigned to RAR jobs must make arrangements for their own transportation to and from the job.

#### **RAR job assignment:**

If a rower receives a referral for a RAR job, either through use of a door hanger advertisement or word of mouth, the rower gets first choice of taking the RAR assignment. The other rower(s) needed for the RAR will be pulled from the RAR list of rowers based on a normal rotation.

#### **Dispersement of money:**

For each RAR job, \$10 per hour worked goes to each rower's fundraising credit and \$10 to the club expense fund. If the RAR job was received as a result of a referral or door hanger, the rower receives the referral gets an additional \$5 towards their fundraising credit. Tips, if received, are split equally among the rowers participating in the job and are applied directly to fundraising credit. All checks are to be made payable to LBRA and payments for RAR services should be directed to Barbara Borenstein from the parent supervising each job.
